

An interview with Philippe Streiff

Ex-F1 French driver, participated in 55 GP achieved 1 podium, and scored 11 points



Jakub Kruczek: Do you remember when you gave your first autograph, how looked this situation and what feeling did you have?

Philippe Streiff: "In 1977, when I got my 1st French Championship (Coupe de l'Avenir)"

Jakub Kruczek: Do you get a lot of requests for autographs?

Philippe Streiff: "Yes... But now I'am quadraplegic, I send old photos !"

Jakub Kruczek: What do you feel when you are giving autographs? Can it be tiring?

Philippe Streiff: "Proud... It's super !"

Jakub Kruczek: Do you get some gifts from fans?

Philippe Streiff: "Yes... Some photos !"

Jakub Kruczek: Is there any difference for you in giving autographs to collectors or fans?

Philippe Streiff: "I like both...!"

Jakub Kruczek: Do you always find time for your fans?

Philippe Streiff: "Yes... Always !"

Jakub Kruczek: From what country are you getting the largest requests for autographs?

Philippe Streiff: "Poland & Australia"

Jakub Kruczek: Could you tell any interesting story about giving autographs?

Philippe Streiff: "Fans who send me inedit & unknown photos of me or my racing cars..."

Jakub Kruczek: As I am Polish what do you think about Robert Kubica? Do you belive in his back to Formula 1 in future?

Philippe Streiff: "He is a very good driver... He won my karting indoor Masters in category "juniors", in 1999, at Paris-Bercy stadium ! I don't think he'll come back in F1... But he does well in WRC... !"

Jakub Kruczek: Emphasis on ecology in Formula 1. Is it not too large?

Philippe Streiff: "No, because F1 will be always a constructor's test for road car, as well 24 H of Le Mans..."
